into your heart.

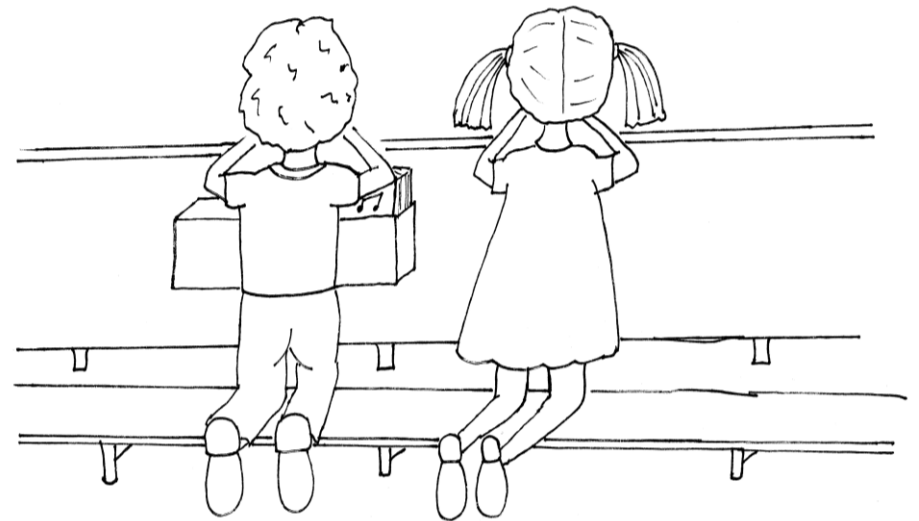
Thank Jesus for inviting you to

to go to Mass every Sunday.

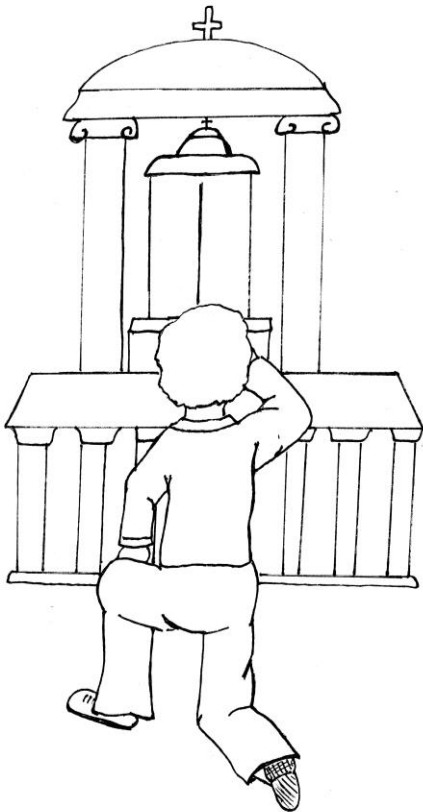
We should never miss

and I love You!"



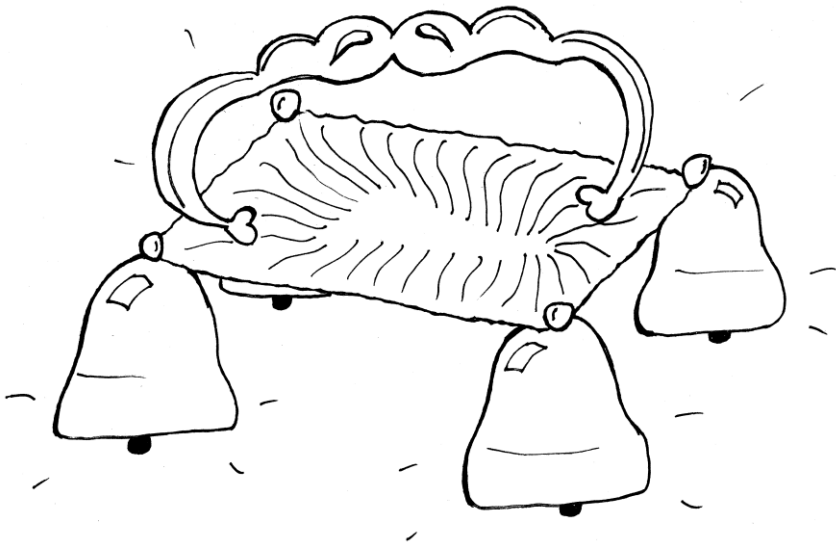
The consecration is when the

is the consecration.

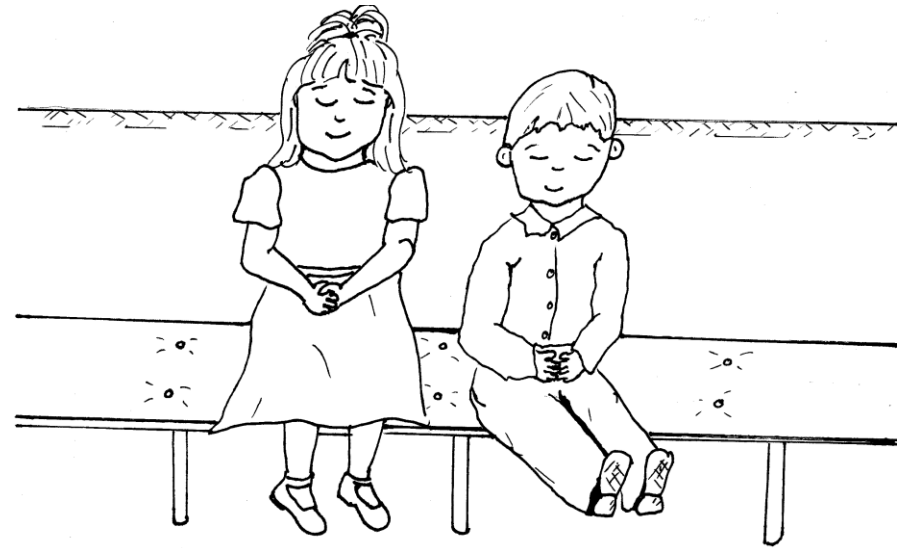
Listen for ringing bells.
